

THE CLIMEPORT PROJECT WAS PRESENTED AT THE GREENPORT CONFERENCE

On February 23rd and 24th the GREENPORT Conference was held in Venice (Italy). The objectives of the event were to create added value through an exchange of experiences and good environmental practices at ports all around the world.

The conference was divided into two sessions, the first under the name of GREENPORT Logistics, which focused on transport and the logistics chain, whereas the second, called ENERGY FOR GREEN PORTS, centred more on environmental aspects.

The conference was opened by authorities of the city and port of Venice and also representations of port associations such as ASSOPORTI (Italian Sea Ports Association) and ESPO (European Sea Ports Association).

A multitude of results and actions were presented at the conference, carried out by numerous ports and private companies offering a point of view on the available technologies as a solution to different environmental problems in the face of the rapid development of ports in response to global market demand.

Along these lines, on February 24th, at session 5, Carbon Footprint in the logistics chain (ports and operators) the CLIMEPORT project was presented at this forum.
